Get ready to experience the wonderful world of The Painted Turtle!
Included in this sheet is important information you'll need to make your way straight to
Lake Hughes, California...**camp capital of the world!** And some helpful tips for your stay.



Arrival & Transportation:

Conference will begin Friday morning, November 9th. Check-in, camp activities, and a camp tour will begin at 9am and run until noon. Lunch will be served at 12pm with the conference officially beginning at 1pm.

Airport Transportation:

Make all flight arrangements into Burbank Airport (BUR). *Plan to arrive into BUR by 10AM on Friday November 9th.* If you are unable to arrive by that time, you will be responsible for your own transportation to camp. Shuttles will be running from the airport to camp on **Friday November 9th at 10:30AM**



Departures: Shuttles will be provided to BUR at 4:30PM on November 10th and 9AM on Sunday November 11th.

** If travel plans are made to a different airport or outside of designated times, you will be responsible for arranging your own transportation to camp.*

Personal Vehicles:

Personal cars are allowed on camp for loading and unloading purposes only. At other times cars must be parked in our parking area to comply with fire codes.



Nut Free Facility:

The Painted Turtle is a peanut and tree nut free facility. Due to camper allergies, food items containing nuts should not be brought onto the camp site at any time. Please check all labels prior to bringing snacks to camp.



Substance Free Facility:

The Painted Turtle is a drug, alcohol, and smoke free facility. There is NO smoking aloud anywhere on camp grounds.



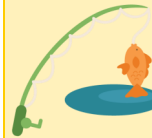
What to Bring:

Linens, pillows, blankets, and towels will be provided by The Painted Turtle. Pack comfortable clothes and closed toe shoes for camp activities. Keep in mind the clothes you will need for walking around camp during the day as well as braving the chilly night air. We recommend a warm jacket, hat, and gloves for November evenings.



Camp Activities:

We have the opportunity to offer you a handful of camp activity experiences. Activity areas will only be open during designated times listed on the schedule. All waterfront areas (fishing dock, boating dock, and pool) are off limits unless a lifeguard is present.



Phones:

AT&T and Verizon are the only cell phone services that get reception at camp. Land lines will be available for use in all program areas, in the Well Shell, and our administration building. If you do not have AT&T or Verizon you can set your smart phone to receive calls/texts via our Wi-Fi signal.



Wi-Fi:

Wi-Fi is available throughout camp! Because technology and Wi-Fi are not always 100% reliable, we recommend saving any presentations and needed documents to a USB drive and/or on your desktop.
